TECHNOLOGY REVIEW & SEMINAR-IV

- 1. The seminar shall have three components, two chosen by the student from the coursework without repetition, from the topics taught / studied, and approved by the faculty advisor.
- 2. The other component is suggested by the advisor and can be a reproduction of the concept in any standard research paper or an extension of concept from earlier course work.
- 3. A hard copy of the information on seminar topic in the form of a report is to be submitted for evaluation along with presentation.
- 4. The presentation of the seminar topics shall be made before a committee comprising the Head, seminar advisor and a senior faculty of the department.
- 5. The three components of the seminar are distributed as three sessions of the semester and are evaluated for 60 marks each.
- 6. The sum of the two components shall be taken as the final score (Max 100). A minimum of 50% of maximum marks shall be obtained to earn the corresponding credits.
